



STATEMENT

Kinshasa, July 6, 2026

Rawbank has learned, through the press, of information recently circulated concerning certain Bank employees in connection with ongoing legal proceedings.

The Bank is also aware of clarifications provided in the official statement issued by the Prosecutor General at the Court of Cassation on July 4, 2026, which notably indicates that the investigations have progressed significantly, that the precautionary measure mentioned in the publications of recent days was lifted before its public dissemination, that it did not constitute a sanction, and that to date, no evidence of the involvement of the individuals concerned has been established; some of the alleged facts have already been the subject of proceedings that resulted in a dismissal.

In this context, Rawbank reaffirms its commitment to respecting the institutions of the Republic, the independence of the judiciary, the proper conduct of judicial proceedings, and the fundamental principle of the presumption of innocence. Rawbank will continue, as it always has, to cooperate fully with the relevant authorities in strict compliance with applicable laws and regulations, and the highest principles of ethics, compliance, and integrity that guide its actions.

The Bank therefore urges the utmost caution regarding the dissemination of information, allegations, or comments not based on duly established facts and likely to create a misleading perception of its activities, governance, or employees, or to damage its reputation, integrity, and the trust of its clients, partners, and other stakeholders. In this regard, Rawbank reserves the right to take any appropriate action, including legal action, in accordance with Congolese law, to protect its rights, interests, and image.

Rawbank continues its operations as usual with the same commitment to serving its clients, partners, and the Congolese economy.
